

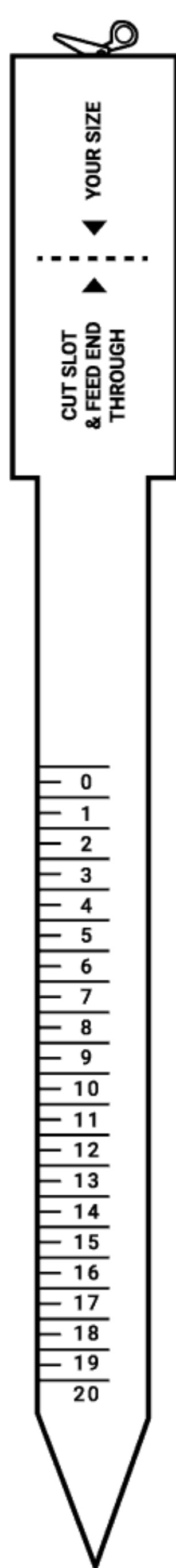
RING SIZE

Say goodbye to the uncertainty and hello to the perfect ring fit with our ring size guide!

No need to panic if you're not sure about your or your partner's ring size! Measuring it without any direct hints can be a bit of a challenge, but nothing we can't handle.

Check out these easy and sneaky tips to crack the size code:

- Take a ring from your partner's jewelry box and trace the inside of the ring on a piece of paper to get an accurate measurement
- Rally the troops! Get your squad or special someone to secretly help you figure out their size.
- It's advisable to select a ring size slightly larger than anticipated



PRINT YOUR RING SIZER:

1. Print out and cut the ring sizer provided below.
2. Wrap the sizer snugly around the widest part of your intended finger, ensuring that the numbers are visible to you.
3. Insert the pointed end through the slit you made in the sizer.
4. Take note of the number that lines up with the slit - this is your ring size!

Some tips for nailing that perfect ring size:

- Don't get stuck with a too-small ring! Remember, our dominant hands are usually a smidge bigger.
- Wider bands tend to fit more snugly, so if you're measuring a ring for your significant other, try to pick one with a similar width to the one you want to buy.
- Temperature matters! Make sure your fingers aren't too hot or too cold when measuring as they can expand or shrink in size.
- Fingers can be a bit fickle and change size throughout the day, so aim to measure towards the end of the day when they're most settled.
- If your knuckle is a bit chunky, take two measurements and opt for a size that falls in the middle. You want it to slide over the knuckle but not be so loose that it wobbles around.
